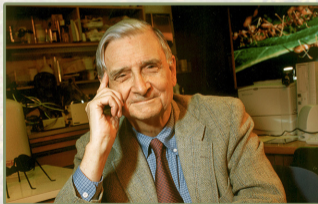

WALDEN WOODS PROJECT GLOBAL ENVIRONMENTAL LEADERSHIP AWARD

The Walden Woods Project *Global Environmental Leadership Award* recognizes significant achievement in the areas of climate stability, biodiversity, conservation, human understanding and behavior, and global environmental policy. The Award draws its inspiration from the innovative thinking of Henry David Thoreau and builds upon his ageless principles of natural resource stewardship, universal interconnectedness, and personal responsibility.

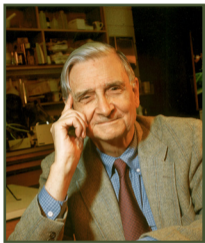
The recipients of this prestigious award have demonstrated a singular ability to motivate the people and institutions necessary to effectively address the environmental challenges of the 21st century. Their achievements serve as a powerful model for all who are concerned about the future of our planet and, ultimately, the earth we convey to future generations.

The physical Award seeks to capture the monumental scope of the global environmental challenge while weaving in the fundamentally human scale of the required solution. It elevates the essential nature of the moral contract between generations and the moment in time when one generation passes into eternity and a new generation accepts the stewardship of the earth.

The Award was created through a collaboration between the Walden Woods Project and renowned bronze sculptor, Mark Hopkins. Based in Loveland, Colorado, Hopkins is considered one of the premier bronze sculptors in the United States today. Hopkins' sculptures are known for their beautifully natural and flowing motion, and for their ability to capture the inner "spirit" of their subjects.



2017 GLOBAL ENVIRONMENTAL LEADERSHIP AWARD HONOREE



Edward O. Wilson In his long and accomplished career, University Research Professor Emeritus at Harvard and this century's most eminent biologist Edward O. Wilson spearheaded efforts to preserve the world's biodiversity. Dr. Wilson's work has earned him more than 100 awards, including the National Medal of Science and two Pulitzer Prizes for Non-fiction. In 2000, he was named one of the century's 100 leading environmentalists by Time magazine.

E.O. Wilson's highly-acclaimed book, *Half-Earth*, proposes an achievable plan to save our imperiled biosphere by devoting half the surface of the Earth to nature, thereby protecting 85 percent of species from extinction. E.O. Wilson has created the groundwork for one of the grandest conservation efforts of our time, the Half-Earth Project (<https://eowilsonfoundation.org>).



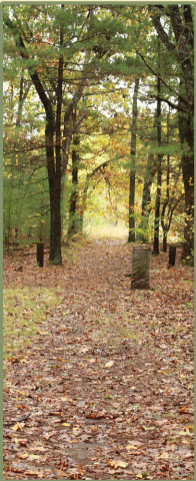
